The officers serve one-year terms while Board members serve two year terms. However, the NAALJ By-laws provide that a Board of Governors member may serve no more than three consecutive terms unless he or she is elected to President-Elect, Secretary, or Treasurer.

When considering whether to nominate yourself or another member for an officer or Board position, please keep in mind that NAALJ is a volunteer organization that depends on its leadership to devote the time and talent necessary to grow our association. It is critically important that NAALJ leaders have the requisite time to devote to a dynamic, working Board charged with expanding membership and continuing our long history of providing exceptional resources for our members and opportunities to interact with colleagues from across the country. Please help the Nominating Committee identify candidates who can contribute in significant ways to NAALJ.
