As the NAALJ Annual Conference nears its start, I want to provide some important information and reminders to help you prepare for the Conference.

Wondering What to Wear?

While attending the education: We suggest business casual. As we are in a hotel with air conditioning, a light jacket, blazer or sweater is suggested during the day.

For Monday's bus trip to Harpers Ferry & Jefferson County Courthouse: A more casual and comfortable dress is suggested. While we do not anticipate a lot of walking, comfortable walking shoes for the day are warranted.

For the Silent Auction and Banquet: Cocktail attire is suggested for this event.

Vaccination or Proof of Testing is Mandatory

As a reminder, masks are required at all NAALJ events.

All attendees and/or guests attending the 2021 NAALJ Annual Conference in Washington, D.C. shall be required to present evidence that they are fully vaccinated (defined as two weeks after the second dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine or the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine, or 2 weeks after the Johnson & Johnson single-shot COVID-19 Vaccine) to be allowed entrance to the NAALJ Conference.

For those not vaccinated, attendees are required to obtain and provide proof of a negative COVID test within 48 hours prior to arrival at the Conference. Attendees

and/or guests who fail to provide such evidence may not attend the conference in person and shall be refunded their conference fee.

To avoid a bottleneck at registration, please email your vaccination card to me at naalj@naalj.org as soon as possible. Vaccination cards are held in the strictest of confidence and are not kept or distributed to anyone. For those not vaccinated, please be prepared to show proof of your negative test at the registration desk. If you need help finding a testing location in Washington, DC, please contact me for assistance.
